- 8. Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem
- 9. Jesus falls a third time
- 10. Jesus is stripped of his garments
- 11. Jesus is nailed to the Cross
- 12. Jesus dies on the Cross
- 13. The body of Jesus is placed in the arms of his mother
- 14. Jesus is laid in the tomb
